
### **History Rediscovered!**

The recently re-discovered choir archives are full of interesting tit-bits. We have a complete list of music performed since the first concert in 1886 except for the period 1961-67. Were there no concerts then? Can anyone help with details if there were?

We are still sorting out the stack of concert information, but it looks as though the earliest we have is that for 1929. The cover for that Messiah performance is below. It is no surprise that Messiah has been popular, having been performed 16 times in whole or part, but Elijah having been performed 10 times before 1960, has only been figured once since. In a year when we are performing at St Andrew's Church in Chippenham, the records show that we have performed there at least twice before.

I had a useful meeting with Carole Browne of the Calne Music and Arts Festival. Both of us want to have Calne Choral as part of the Festival. They offered us Saturday 7 October; the first Saturday and with no other event that evening, which is the date your Committee preferred. St Mary's Church has been booked.
